MASTERCLASS DETAILS

Dr. Horowitz will discuss classical and integrative methods to help those with chronic, resistant disease.

- Recognize the limitations and strengths of present diagnostic tests
- Learn the most common differential diagnoses in patients with chronic fatigue as well as musculoskeletal disorders accompanied by neurocognitive difficulties
- Understand how to choose and rotate antibiotic and herbal protocols based on symptoms and laboratory testing
- Create a logical diagnostic and treatment plan based on abnormalities on the 16-point MSIDS model
- Use newer “persister” protocols and agents that disrupt biofilms in both Lyme disease and associated co-infections to enhance therapeutic efficacy

RICHARD HOROWITZ, MD

Richard Horowitz is a board-certified internist in private practice in Hyde Park, NY. He is the medical director of the Hudson Valley Healing Arts Center, an integrative medical center that combines classical and complementary approaches to the treatment of Lyme disease and other tick-borne disorders.

Dr. Horowitz has provided clinical preceptorships for the past two decades for practitioners nationwide and across Europe. He has treated over 13,000 chronic Lyme disease patients and is a founding member of the International Lyme and Associated Diseases Society (ILADS) and past president of the International Lyme and Associated Diseases Educational Foundation (ILADEF).

In his New York Times best-selling book “Why Can’t I Get Better? Solving the Mystery of Lyme and Chronic Disease,” Dr. Horowitz explains his full diagnostic and treatment approach to patients who have complex tick-borne illnesses. Dr. Horowitz’s second book, another national best-seller, is titled “How Can I Get Better? An Action Plan for Treating Resistant Lyme and Chronic Disease.”

Dr. Horowitz is a popular guest on TV and radio, and he lectures nationally and internationally. He is a member of the HHS Tick-Borne Disease Working Group, which recently provided the United States Congress with recommendations for the diagnosis and treatment of tick-borne disorders.
